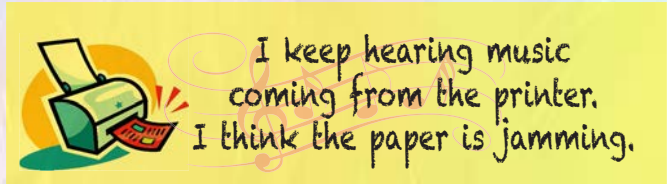


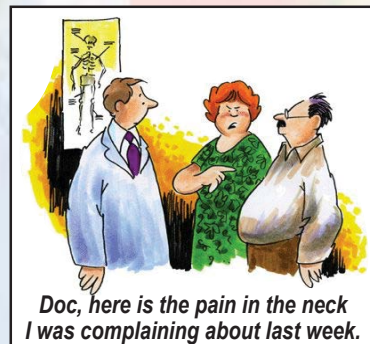
My great-aunt looked confused when I told her that my son was 8 months old. "Oh," she said. "I thought she was a year and a half."
