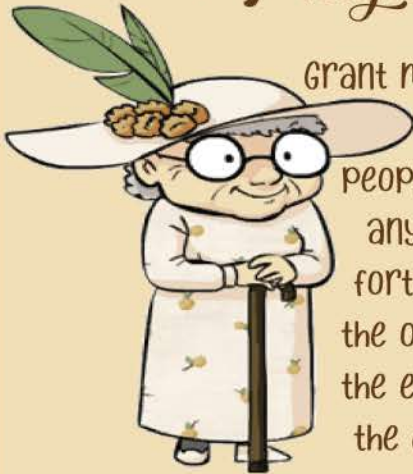


# The Senility Prayer

Jack responded, *"The water, the electric and the cable."*

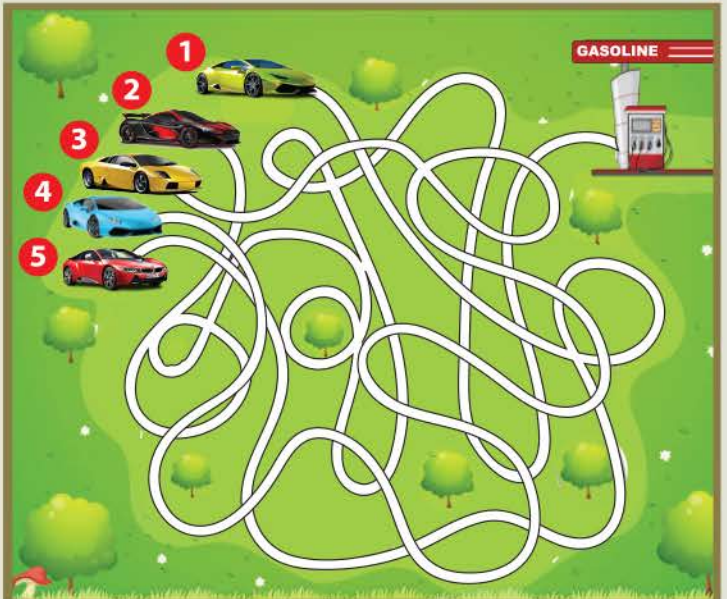
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Son: *"Dad, when will I be old enough so I don't have to ask mom for her permission to go out?"*
